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1. Product Overview



1.1 Parts

- 1. Multivent ventilation pipe
- 2. Multivent hybrid fan
- 3. Ventilation ducting
- 4. Airtight sleeve
- 5. Screw tabs

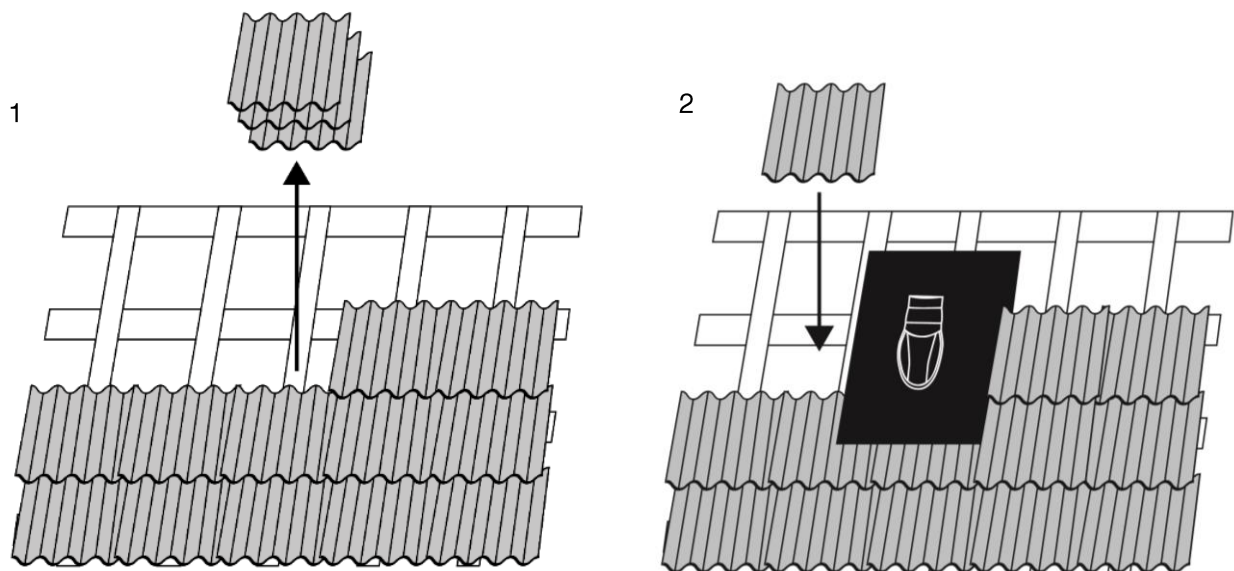
- 6. 2 x hose clamps
- 7. High-tack sealant
- 8. Ubiflex ventilation roof flashing
- 9. Ventilation grille

2. Installation Steps

2.1 Step 1 – Fit the Ubiflex ventilation roof flashing

Remove sufficient tiles from the roof to allow the flashing to fit down onto the tile battens as shown below.

Determine the ideal position so that the flashing can be installed beneath the tiles above / to the sides and down onto the tiles below.



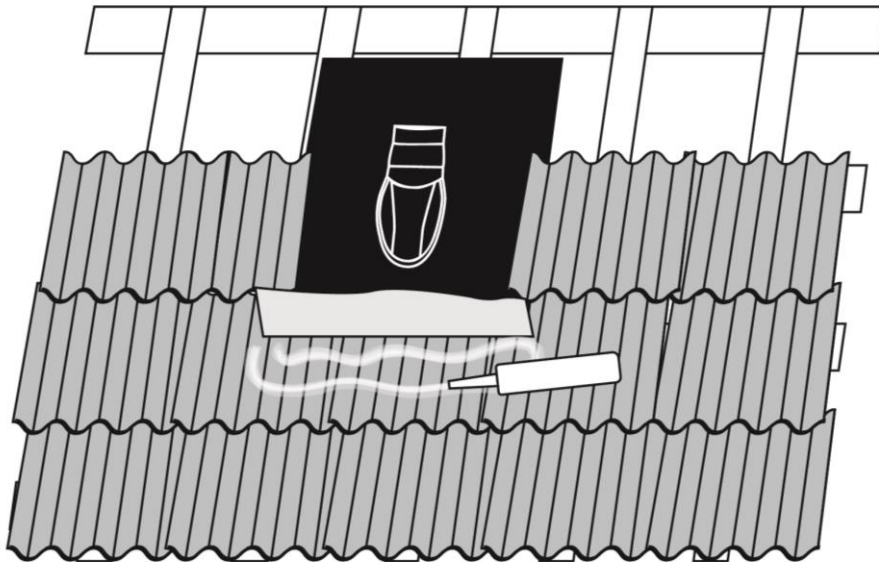
Create a weather stop by folding the sides and top of the flashing upwards by a few centimetres.

Dress the bottom skirt of the flashing down onto the profile of the tiles below.

2.2 Step 2 – High-Tack sealant / adhesive

Secure the lower skirt of the flashing down onto the tiles below with the High-tack adhesive / sealant provided.

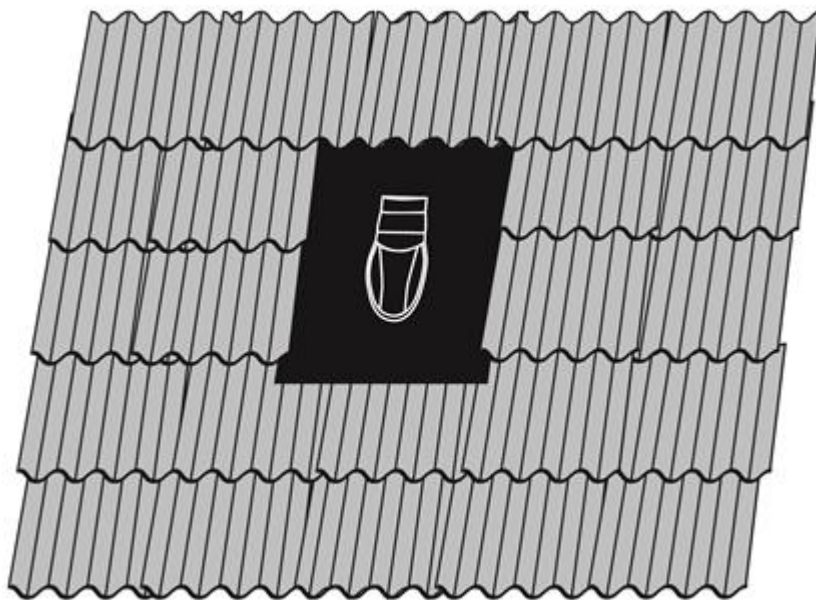
Tip: Ensure that the tiles below the flashing skirt are free from dust and debris prior to applying the High-tack adhesive/sealant



Push the bottom edge of the flashing down firmly.

Fit the roof tiles back around the sides and top of the roof flashing.

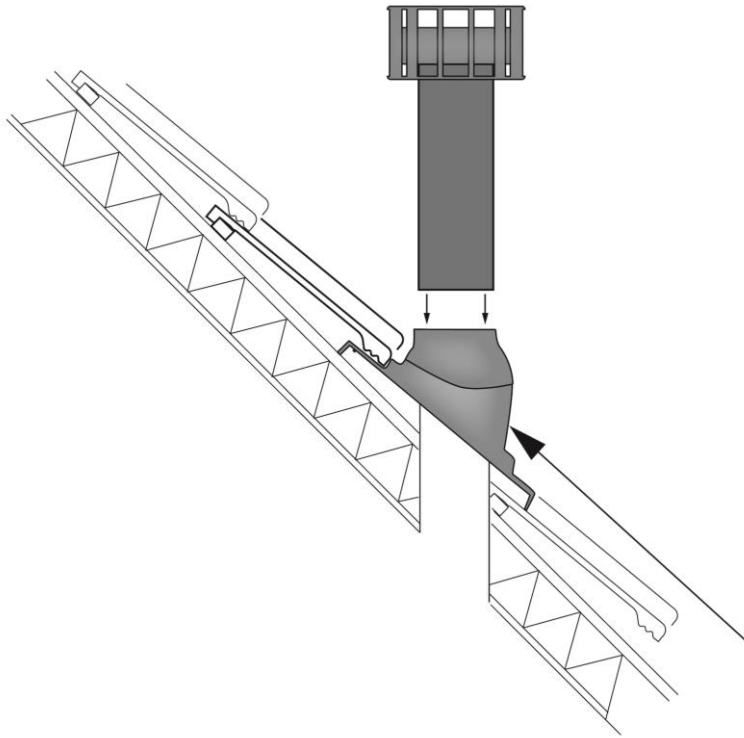
Note: The sides of the flashing must be overlapped by the roof tiles



2.3 Step 3 – Fit the ventilation pipe

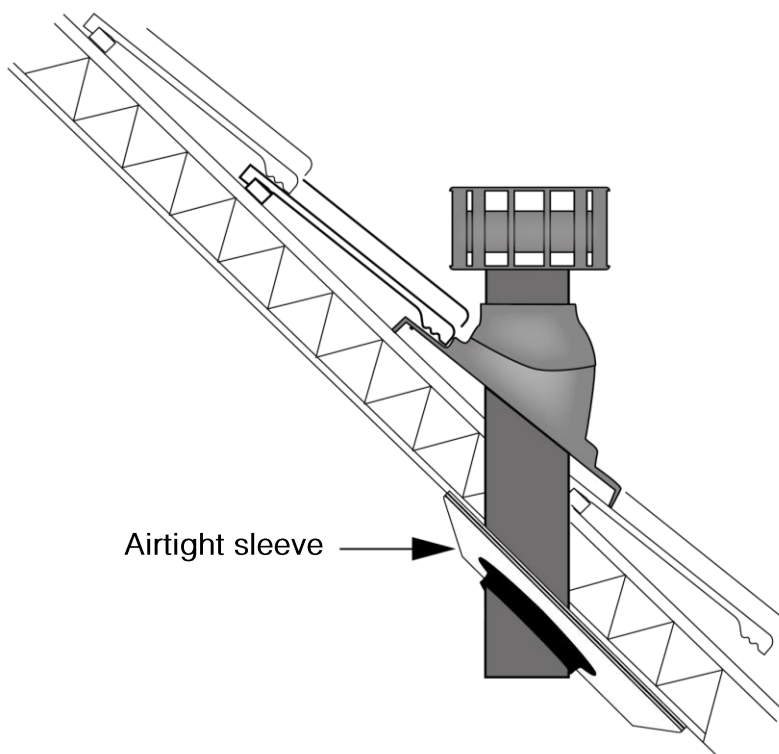
Carefully slide the ventilation pipe down through the Ubiflex roof flashing.

Tip: The ventilation pipe can be shortened if necessary.



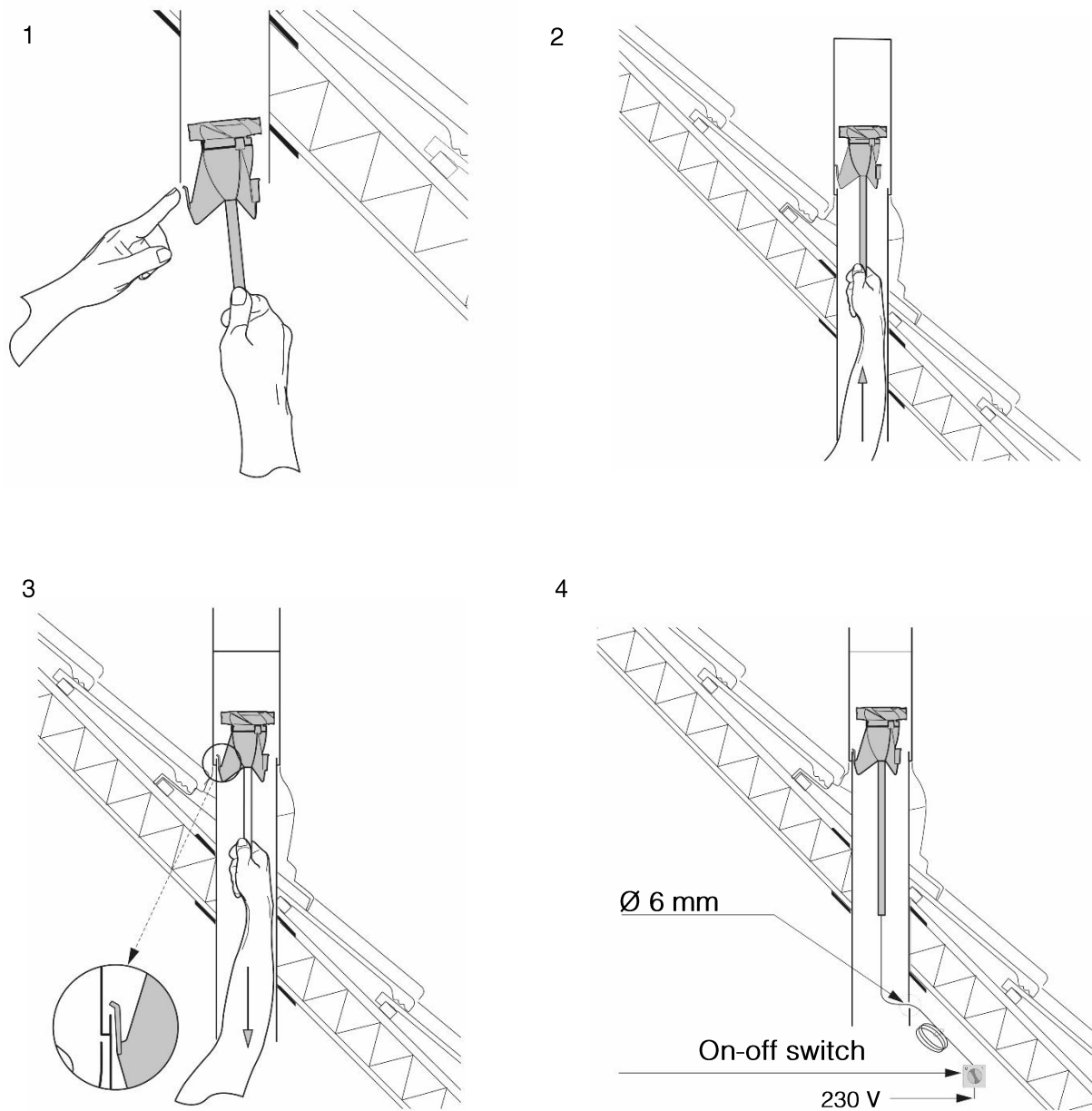
2.4 Step 4 – Install the airtight sleeve

Install the airtight sleeve over the pipe tight up against the underside of the roof to create an airtight seal as shown below.



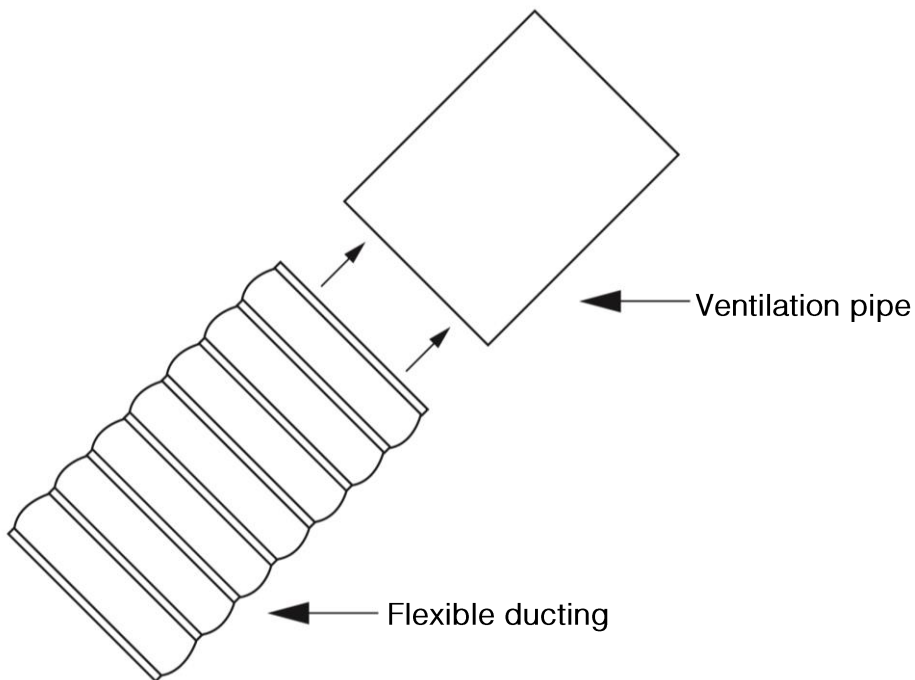
2.5 Step 5 – Fit the fan motor unit

Carefully push the fan motor unit up through the ventilation pipe until it locates into place as shown below.



2.6 Step 6 – Connect flexible ducting

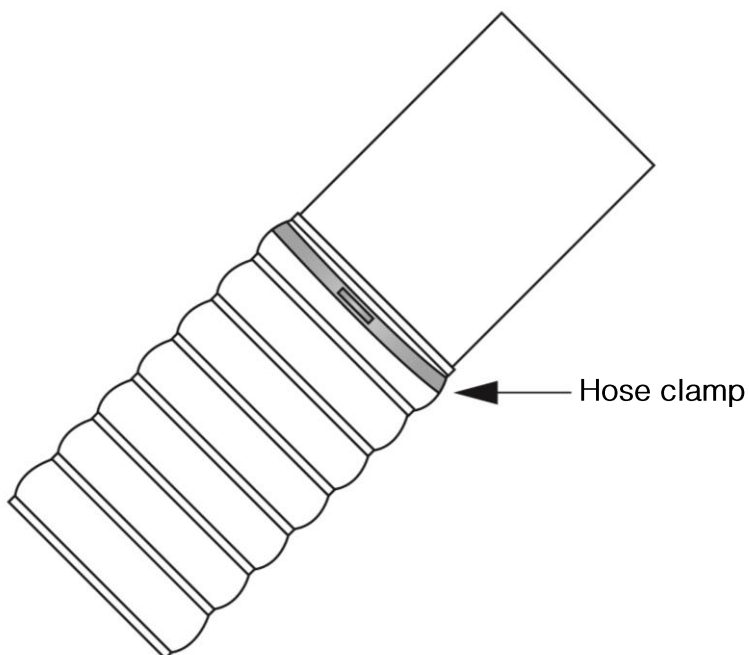
Fit the end of the flexible ducting over the end of the ventilation pipe.



2.7 Step 7 – Fit a hose clamp

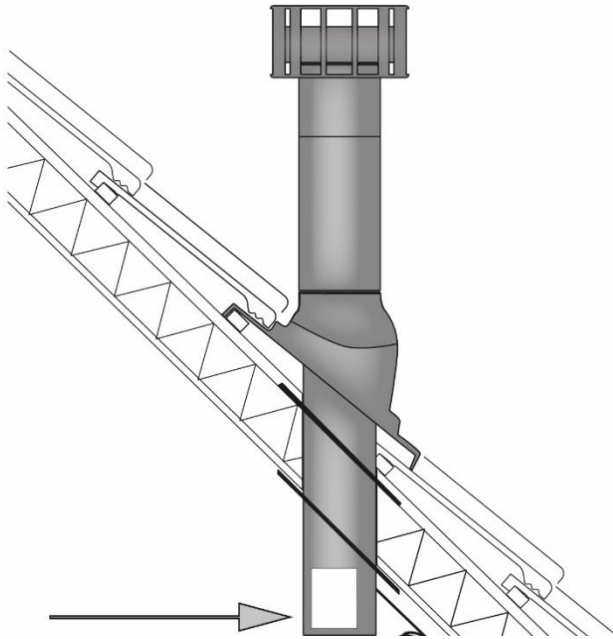
Secure the flexible ducting onto the end of the ventilation pipe with one of the hose clamps supplied.

Note: A hose clamp will need to be fitted at the top and bottom of the flexible ducting to secure it into place.



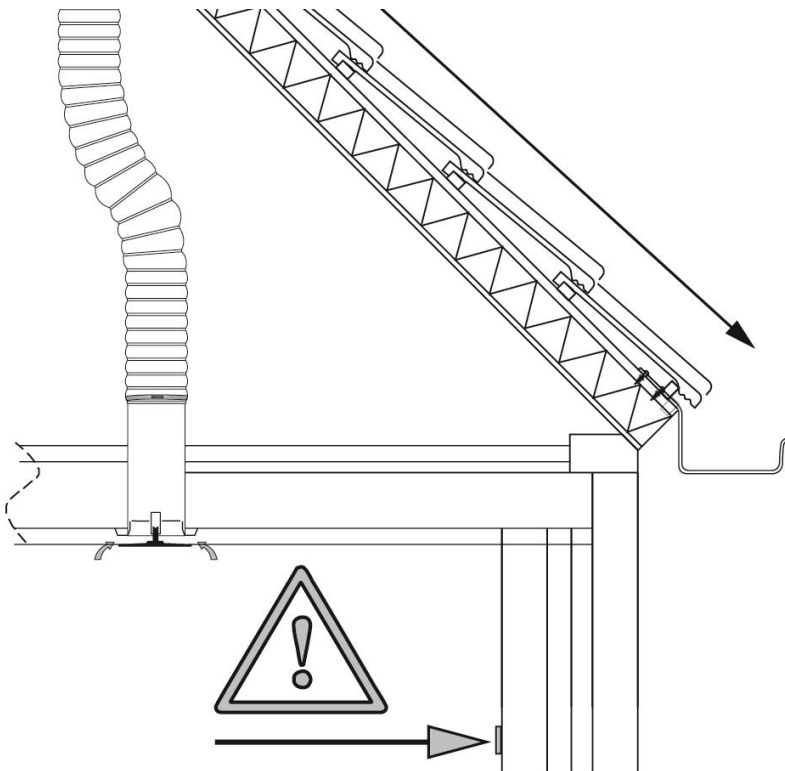
2.8 Step 8 – Apply the maintenance sticker

Stick the supplied maintenance instruction sticker onto the ventilation pipe.



2.9 Step 9 – Switch installation

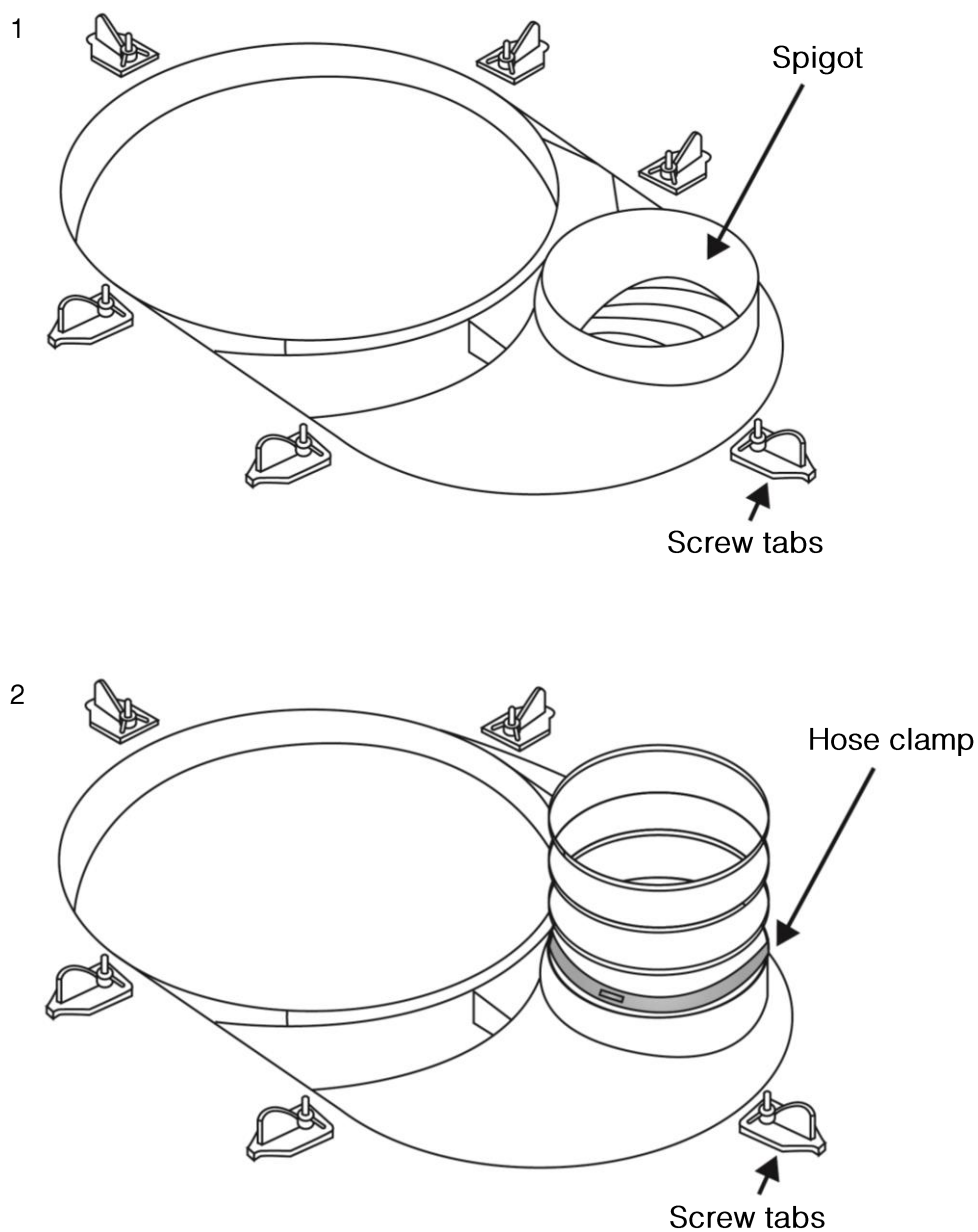
Ensure that the switch for the ventilation system is a separate switch.



2.10 Step 10 – Install the ceiling ventilation grille

Install the ventilation grille into the ceiling opening with the ceiling screws, using the screw tabs for reinforcement.

Connect the bottom end of the flexible ducting to the spigot on the back of the grille and secure it in place with the remaining hose clamp.



This completes the installation of your ventilation system.
